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# 1.0 Project Background, Overview and Scope

## 1.1 Background

In September 2024, River Parish Sequestration, LLC (“RPS”), a wholly owned subsidiary of Blue Sky Infrastructure, LLC, was awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Energy (“DOE”) under the Carbon Storage Assurance Facility Enterprise (“CarbonSAFE”) Program to perform site characterization and permitting activities for the first phase of the River Parish Sequestration Project (“Project”) in Louisiana.

In June 2025, RPS selected and contracted Brammer Engineering, Inc. (“Brammer”) to be their Project Manager.

## 1.2 Overview

Brammer is now requesting bids for long lead materials and services related to the Project for the stratigraphic test well (the “Test Well”) with an anticipated spud in between October 2025 and January 2026. The desired materials and/or services have long lead times due to required material composition and specifications necessary to withstand the environment of the Test Well. Brammer will provide no less than thirty (30) days notice prior to the tentative commencement of the Project.

Prior to issuing this RFP, RPS completed the engineered well design and submitted the Class V application, located [here](#), to the Louisiana Department of Energy and Natural Resources (“LDENR”) for the Test Well.
